

FOR IMMEDIATE HELP

- To report concerns that are life threatening, you should contact Victoria Police: 000
- To report concerns about the immediate safety of a child outside of normal business hours, you should contact the After-Hours Child Protection Emergency Service on 13 12 78.
- To report a matter to CCYP (The Commission for Children and Young People) under the Reportable Conduct Scheme: 13 12 78

TO MAKE A REPORT TO AUTHORITIES IN VICTORIA

- Reports to child protection must be made to a protective intervener, or other appropriately delegated officer: our Child Safety Officer or one of the contacts listed below
- To make a report, you should contact the child protection intake service covering the local government area (LGA) where the child normally resides. (Reports cannot be made via the DHHS website or email, as staff who monitor the department's website are not delegated officers.)

Telephone numbers to make a report to DHHS during business hours (8.45am -5.00pm), Monday to Friday, are listed below:

North Division intake: 1300 664 977 South Division intake: 1300 655 795 East Division intake: 1300 360 391

West Division intake - metropolitan: 1300 664 977

West Division intake - rural and regional: 1800 075 599
